Theses of reports will be published before the conference. Abstracts should be submitted in electronic format in 1 page of the WinWord editor. A4 paper size with margins: left - 22.5 mm, right - 22.5 mm, top - 20 mm and bottom - 30 mm, font is Times New Roman Cyr 12 pt, single interval between lines (12 pt).

The sequence of materials presentation in the theses: title of report (bold, 12 pt, uppercase and lowercase letters, centered alignment, spacing before a paragraph is 12 pt and after a paragraph is 6 pt); the authors' surnames and initials, the organization full title, country (centered alignment, spacing before and after a paragraph is 6 pt); text of theses with justified alignment. Revised text (without edits) should not contain a bibliography, drawings and formulas if it's possible. Theses should almost entirely fill the page. Theses that do not meet these requirements will be rejected.

Request about your participation in the conference and theses of report, designed in accordance with the specified requirements, should be submitted to the Organizing Committee not later than 10 December 2020

Along with the theses, articles can be submitted for publication in the "Science and progress of transport. Herald of Dnipro National University of Railway Transport" journal (http://stp.diit.edu.ua), which are appropriate to its subjects and designed by the requirements of journal and HAC of Ukraine. (publication should be paid)
